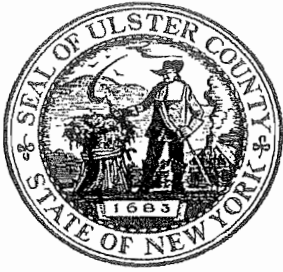
Re: Polling Site Consolidation
