Hours of Operation: Monday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday 8:00am – 4:00pm

Annual Resident Fee: \$20.00. Annual Permits are available at the Town Clerk's Office at Town Hall, on Route 209, in Stone Ridge 687-7601 x 6. Permits are valid for 1 year, starting April 1st.

Cash is not accepted at the Transfer Station. You may pay exact fee amounts or purchase \$10 or \$20 dollar denomination punch cards at the Transfer Station by check only, payable to "Town of Marbletown". Punch cards may also be purchased, by cash or check, in the Town Clerk's Office, at Town Hall.

Hazardous materials are not accepted. Please call Ulster County Resource Recovery at 336-0600 for information on safe hazardous materials disposal.

Commercial construction/demolition debris is not accepted at the Transfer Station. Ulster County Resource Recovery has specific sites in Kingston and New Paltz for these items. Call 255-6358 for New Paltz site or 336-6893 for the Kingston site. The only construction/demolition debris accepted will be a limited amount, by individual homeowners only.

Recyclables Information:

- Recyclables to be placed in designated containers
- Plastic toys, utensils, hoses, buckets, medicine vials, siding, clothing or other plastic items **are not** accepted in recycle bins. Transfer Station Staff will clarify appropriate disposal options.
- Cardboard and Paper Bags: clean, dry, corrugated and "gray board" flattened and tied according to type. Dirty, greasy, painted, waxed or otherwise contaminated cardboard not accepted.
- Newsprint must be clean and can go into the same container with computer paper, junk mail, magazines, phone books, paperback, hardcover books with covers removed. **No bags or boxes.**
- Glass **must be separated** from Metal Cans and Plastic Bottles/Containers, as they go into separate bins.
- Glass and Plastic containers must be clean and rinsed with lids removed.
- Tin and Aluminum cans must be clean, with lids removed.
- Pots, pans, clothes hangers, etc. can be placed in the metal pile.
- Large Metal Items (other than freezers, fridges, air conditioners/w coolant chemicals) can be placed in the Metal Collection Area.
- Paint Cans must be empty of any residue and must be dry with the lids off.
- Compost: Grass clippings and leaves only.
- Clothing: Usable clothing and shoes may be deposited in the collection bins at the gate.

No metal materials, which have been placed in the scrap pile, are to leave the Transfer Station. Scrap metal is a source of revenue for the residents of Marbletown. Reusable items, such as bicycles, working appliances, etc. will be made available to the public at the discretion of the Station Team Leader. **Thank you** for your cooperation in helping us to maintain a safe, friendly and efficient Community Transfer Station.
