o Signage

- Install Tick warning signs on all Kiosks (Done, 9/26)
- Weed whack Rest Plaus Parking exit area and install Stop O&W Arrow signs (Done 9/26 and 10/7)
- Replace grafittied Resident Respect sign along Wood/Meier property line (Done 9/26)
- Remove old NYS Grant sign at Leggett Road parking entrance (**Done 9/26**)

o Tree removal

- Remove several dead ash trees on north end of Cottekill north (highway)
- Remove large dead leaner north of north end of beaver pond (**Partially Done 10/1**)
- Remove large dead leaner between K9 marker and trail bench at Leggett north (**Done**)
- Remove dead ash stump blocking trail south of Rest Plaus before Grist Mill (**Done 9/26**)

o College Connector

- Rough out trail from Ridge gym to college (approximately 1000 feet) (Done, 10/1,
 Davenport property only) Need to do Gym property back line and SUNY Property)
- Complete ROW agreements for Ridge Gym and Davenport properties (Town Attorney)
- Planning Board approval of ROWs
- Walkway construction assessment and cost estimate from Highway Department

o Rest Plaus road parking completion (Highway)

- Install stone blocks at parking lot edge ((Done 9/2019))
- Install 10' gates donated by Williams Lake project (10/8, done needs re-leveling)

o Other Highway

- Flail mow trail side walls where required
- Open up drainage ditch with backhoe south of Rest Plaus near arched tree ((Done 12/2019))
- Prepare for utility pole donation from Williams Lake project at Leggett and Cottekill south parking lots
- New item; Lilac Hill needs major drainage adjustment. Same for Cottekill segment south hill.

- Follow up on potential parking at old Heritagenergy LP depot ((10/2019) no permission))
- Coordinate with Rail Trail Historic Sign Committee design, completion, and installation
- Thoughts on purchase of motorized hand tools by town for use by committee members
