DETERMINATION OF SIGNIFICANCE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT (6 CRR-NY 617.7) FOR THE GRADY PARK & HIGH FALLS GATEWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Town of Marbletown is embarking upon a park and community gateway improvement project, known as the **Grady Park & High Falls Gateway Improvement Project**, located in the Hamlet of High Falls on land between the current and former road alignments of NYS Route 213;

WHEREAS, the proposed action has been determined to be an Unlisted Action, pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617, the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (hereinafter "SEQR");

WHEREAS, the Town Board has prepared Part 1 and 2 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form to be in accordance with SEQR;

WHEREAS, the Town Board determined that more than one agency is involved in the project; therefore, a coordinated review was completed;

WHEREAS, the Town Board served by mail a "Notice of Intent to Establish Lead Agency" to two (2) involved agencies, New York State Department of Transportation, and the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation;

WHEREAS, all Agencies replied to the notice, within the required thirty (30) day review period advising that each Agency has no objection to the Town of Marbletown assuming Lead Agency status for this project;

WHEREAS, the Town Board Establish itself as the Lead Agency for the SEQR review;

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed Parts 1 and 2 of the Short Environmental Assessment Forms and other related project materials and based on this information has determined that the proposed actions will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts; now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Town Board authorizes the Town Clerk to file the Negative Declaration in accordance with the applicable provisions of State law.
