RESOLUTION # -2021 OPEN SPACE INSTITUTE (OSI) GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Open Space Institute is applying to the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) for a grant under Title 9 of the Environmental Protection Act of 1993 for a park project to be located in the towns of Hurley, Marbletown, Rochester, Wawarsing, Mamakating and Deer Park, as well as the Villages of Ellenville and Wurtsboro and the Cities of Kingston and Port Jervis, a portion of which is located within the territorial jurisdiction of this Council; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement under the rules of this program, said not-for-profit corporation must obtain the "approval/endorsement of the governing body of the municipality in which the project will be located";

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by this august body that the Town of Marbletown Town Board, hereby does approve and endorse the application of Open Space Institute for a grant under Title 9 of the Environmental Protection Act of 1993 for a park project to conduct a feasibility study to create a comprehensive master plan for the entire length of the O&W rail bed stretching from the City of Kingston all the way to the City of Port Jervis intended to guide improvement of the rail bed and eliminate numerous gaps to maximize the potential of the trail for recreation, transportation, quality of life, connectivity, and economic development.
