PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Marbletown will hold a Public Hearing on April 4, 2023 at 6:00pm to hear all interested parties on the proposed Local Law Known as “Prior Written Notice”, providing for written notification of defects and obstructions on town highways, bridges, streets, sidewalks, crosswalks, and culverts in the Town of Marbletown, at the Rondout Municipal Center, 1925 Lucas Ave, Cottekill NY.

Notice of Highway Defects

Local Law No. __ of the Year 2023

A local law providing for written notification of defects and obstructions on town highways, bridges, streets, sidewalks, crosswalks, and culverts in the Town of Marbletown.

Be it enacted by the town board of the Town of Marbletown.

Section 1. No civil actions shall be maintained against the town or town superintendent of highways for damages or injuries to person or property sustained by reason of any highway, bridge, street, sidewalk, crosswalk, or culvert being defective, out of repair, unsafe, dangerous, or obstructed unless written notice of such defective, unsafe, dangerous, or obstructed condition of such highway, bridge, street, sidewalk, crosswalk, or culvert was actually given to the town clerk or town superintendent of highways, and there was a failure or neglect within a reasonable time after the giving of such notice to repair or remove the defect, danger, or obstruction complained of. No such action shall be maintained for damages or injuries to person or property sustained solely in consequence of the existence of snow or ice upon any highway, bridge, street, sidewalk, crosswalk, or culvert, unless written notice thereof, specifying the particular place, was actually given to the town clerk or town superintendent of highways and there was failure or neglect to cause such snow or ice to be removed, or to make the place otherwise reasonably safe within a reasonable time after the receipt of such notice.

Section 2. The town superintendent of highways shall transmit in writing to the town clerk within five days after the receipt thereof all written notices received pursuant to this local law and subdivision 2 of section 65-a of the Town Law. The town clerk shall cause all written notices received pursuant to this local law and subdivision 2 of section 65-a of the Town Law, to be presented to the town board within five days of the receipt thereof or at the next succeeding town board meeting, whichever shall be sooner.

Section 3. This local law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Marbletown subdivisions 1 and 3 of section 65-a of the Town Law.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
