The following Resolution was offered by Councilman _____seconded by Councilman_____:

RESOLUTION # -2022; REQUESTING A SPEED STUDY ON STATE ROUTE 209

WHEREAS, the Town Board does not have the authority to designate a speed zone for this area; and

WHEREAS, State Route 209 is a New York State highway, and has multiple public ingresses and egresses that access multiple houses and businesses along its entire length, and

WHEREAS, said section of road has multiple individual driveways on both sides, and

WHEREAS, said road is a two-lane highway with no divider separating opposing lanes, and

WHEREAS, the current speed limit of 55 mph on a large section of said road is too high and poses a traffic safety hazard and has resulted in multiple fatal accidents in the past five years, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes the passing zone just south of Schoonmaker Lane should be removed, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Marbletown agrees that the speed limit is too high and should be lowered to 45 mph, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; the Town Board of the Town of Marbletown hereby requests that the New York State Department of Transportation conduct a speed study on State Route 209 in Stone Ridge from Ulster County Route 2, also known as Kripplebush Road to the stoplight at State Route 213 East.
