Supervisor Warren called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance and a welcome to all those in attendance.

### PUBLIC HEARING ON 2017 TOWN, HIGHWAY AND HIGH FALLS WATER BUDGET:

- Supervisor Warren made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Clarke to open the public hearing on the 2017 budget for general and highway for the Town of Marbletown. 4-0 Aye; 1 absent; motion carried.
- Supervisor Warren confirmed with Town Clerk Moody that the legal notice of 'Notice of Public Hearing' was posted and sent to the Daily Freeman for publication. Copies of this notice are available in the Town Clerk's office.
- The floor was open to public comment. Resident, Jack Boden, had a comment addressing a reserve for the High Falls Water District. Supervisor Warren asked Mr. Boden to hold his comment to the public comment section of the public hearing for the water district.
- Councilman Adams made a comment that the elected officials salaries should equalize as much as possible
  across the board and this year's budget does not indicate that. Supervisor Warren stated the Town Board
  votes on the salaries.
- No more comments from the Board. The hearing was closed by resolution #45.

Mr. Boden made comment that at a tour of the High Falls water plant Mr. Terry Johnson, Superintendent, stated that the equipment was very expensive and had life expectancy of 20 years. Mr. Boden stated that back in 2007 there was \$15,000 set aside in the tentative budget for issues/repairs that may come up. Mr. Boden recommended that the Board establish a reserve fund for possible issues/repairs down the line.
- Brian Pickard, town accountant, stated there is a reserve fund and they have been putting money into in for the past 4-5 years.
